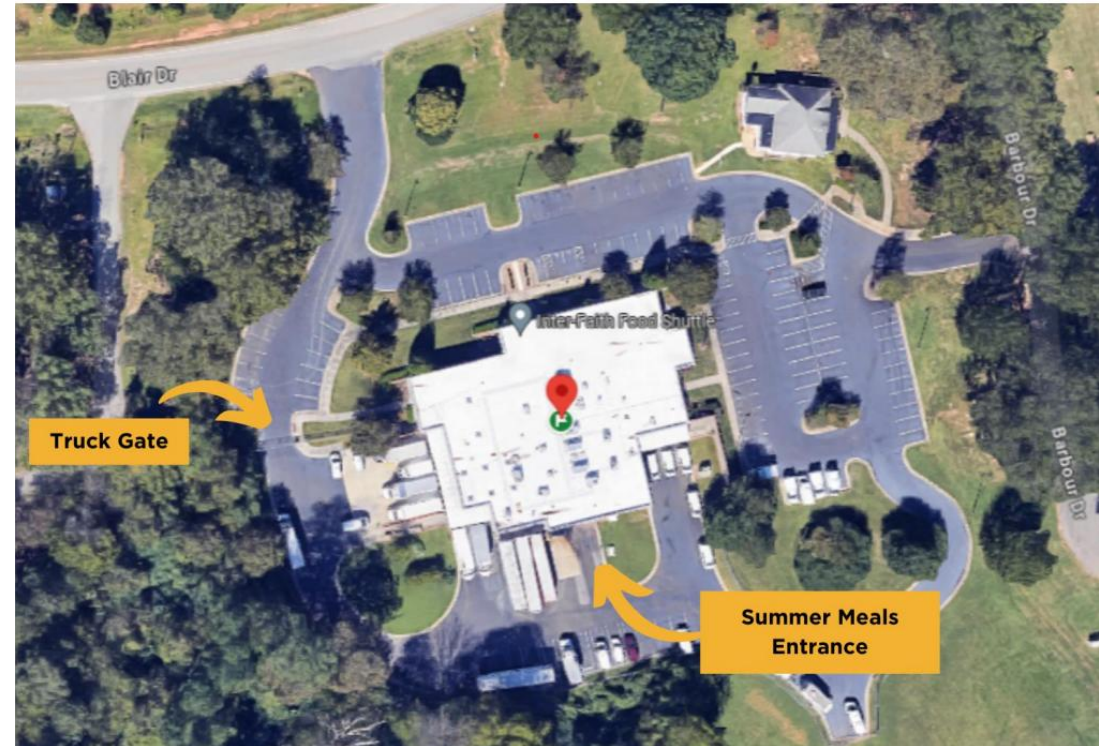

Where to Park, Check In, & Return Paperwork?

Address: 1001 Blair Dr, Raleigh, NC

- Once you turn into the Food Shuttle parking lot, continue through the truck gate.
- Follow the Summer Meals signs to the back.
- Locate the kitchen loading dock and back door.
 - It is the second loading dock in the back.
- Volunteers may park in open parking spaces along the fence near the vans. **DO NOT PARK IN FRONT OF THE BLUE DUMPSTERS!**
- A Food Shuttle employee will be at the dock to greet volunteers. Please tell them which route you are signed up to deliver to, or if you are returning items.
- Volunteers must have a hair covering (i.e., hairnet or hat) and closed-toe shoes to enter the kitchen.





Loading Dock

If you do not see anyone outside, volunteers are welcome to enter the kitchen. Volunteers can walk to the back of the kitchen to meet our Food Shuttle staff. **Please identify your role as a Summer Meals Volunteer with the Food Shuttle!**

Please be mindful that this is an operating loading dock with several trucks and large vehicles passing through the lot. **DO NOT PARK IN FRONT OF THE BLUE DUMPSTERS.**

***Volunteers must have a hair covering and closed-toe shoes to enter the kitchen to enter the kitchen.**



Food Containers (a.k.a. Cambros)



*Please ensure your car is clean and there is enough space to transport food. Certain routes require 2-3 Cambros and 1-3 milk crates.

Volunteers are asked to return used/emptied Cambros and milk crates from the sites if available.
